The Lenfest Foundation Awards Scholarships to 18 Students

WEST CONSHOHOCKEN, PA – The Lenfest Foundation has awarded 18 Pennsylvania public school students scholarships to attend college preparatory boarding schools.

The students will receive a Lenfest Scholarship, which provides tuition, room and board to one of three Pennsylvania college preparatory boarding schools. The Lenfest College Preparatory Program is designed to help promising public school students from rural areas. Students from five public school districts in Franklin County and from select school districts in Adams, Chester and Montgomery counties were eligible to receive scholarships.

The following students were selected to receive the prestigious Lenfest Scholarship. They will enter prep school in the fall of 2007.
